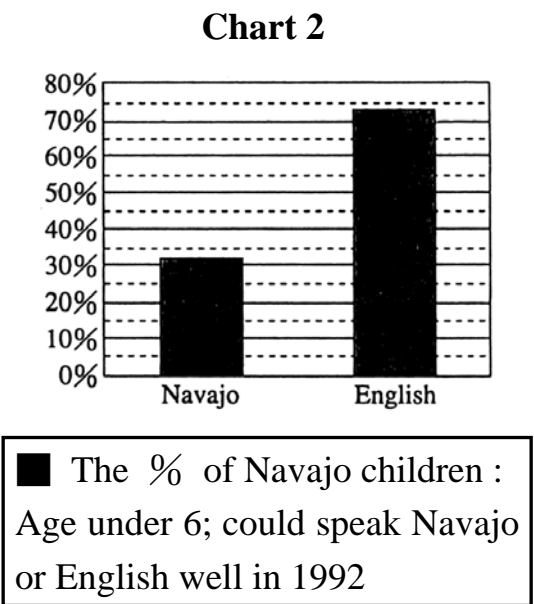

Though you may have never seen it, code is everywhere—behind every web page you visit, every app you use, and every video game you play. Coding has become a helpful skill. Knowing several coding languages well is important for engineers. In fact, some basic understanding of the languages can do anyone good, even if you're not planning to become a master coder or you don't plan to have jobs in software engineering(軟體工程).

To begin with, learning coding languages, or computer programming languages, makes your problem-solving skills better. It teaches you organization skills and how to break problems down into smaller ones. As Apple cofounder Steve Jobs famously said, "Everybody should learn a computer language because it teaches you how to think." As an extra skill, coding is useful for people with different jobs. Whether you're a writer, an artist, or a salesman, you can use your skill of coding to build a website for your business.


While the software market goes on growing, coding skills stay in high demand. It is said that with new technology, millions of jobs are going to be lost to computers in coming years. However, every computer or other machines we put to work will be in need of coding.

If you want to learn to code, start by choosing a computer language. If you're planning a job in coding, start with a more difficult one like the C programming language. For many people, a good place to begin is HTML and CSS, two of the most common computer languages used in building web pages. Both of them are easy to learn, and they're useful in many kinds of jobs.

Where can you learn to code? The Internet offers a great many free training sites like Khan Academy and Codecademy. Such sites teach you by building up ideas little by little and having learners work on small pieces of work like creating a game or building a basic website. Also, paid sites, such as Lynda.com, offer classes with video teaching from famous teachers. Other ways to learn are a large number of apps and games. Now, companies have even sold toys, such as electronic building blocks. The toys teach basic ideas about coding to young children.

Mars: Have scientists just found water on the red planet?

July 26,2018

Researchers have found that there could be liquid water on Mars. Over the years, Mars has got colder, making most of its water become ice. Now the discovery of liquid water is very exciting because this is greatly important for life.

It is believed that there is a lake about 20km wide, and about 1.5km under the planet's south polar ice cap. The discovery was with the help of Marsis. It is a radar on board the Mars Express Orbiter(火星特快車號) of ESA (歐洲太空總署). It wasn't able to work out the depth of the lake, but researchers don't think it's more than one meter.

It's not the first time that researchers got excited about water on Mars. Nasa's(美國國家航太總署) Curiosity Rover(火星探測車好奇號) moved over lake beds on the outside of Mars in the past. Their studies found possible signs that water could have been there sometime.

Marsis' finding is the first sign that at the present time there's a body of liquid water staying on Mars. This is a really big deal. For the water to stay as a liquid under the ice cap, it must be pretty cold. So, scientists think that there might be a lot of salt in it. The salt would stop it from freezing. "This would make the water pretty difficult for life," said Dr. Claire Cousins, a researcher from the University of St Andrews.

So, what now? Well, researchers need to get down to the lake! And this is no easy work. Prof Orosei from the Italian National Institute for Astrophysics(義大利國家天文物理研究所) said that they will need to fly a robot to Mars to dig through 1.5km of ice. They will surely need some new machines, but that type of machines, at the moment, are not available.
