



James Harrison, an Australian boy, had an operation on his lungs in 1951. The surgery lasted several hours and he survived though he was in the hospital for three months. When James learned that his survival was because of the large amount of blood he had received, he decided to start giving blood when he was 18. Even if he was scared of seeing needles, he still began to give large amounts of blood, and a few years later, doctors realized that his blood was special.

In the 1950s, millions of babies died from rhesus disease each year. This affects up to 17% of babies, and could be fatal. In the 1960s, doctors investigated rhesus disease and developed anti-D, a way of curing the disease. However, anti-D needed blood, and only a few people were able to give the right kind. James was one of them, and all anti-D in Australia was made with his blood until 2015.

Anti-D had saved millions of babies' lives all over the world since it was invented. It's said Jame's blood saved 2.4 million babies, including his own children. James was still modest and said that he was the same as anyone else who gave blood. James gave blood as often as every two weeks, and he had done this 1173 times by his 81st birthday. Australian law doesn't allow people to give blood at this age of 81, but there's no doubt that Jame's good deeds will live on.
