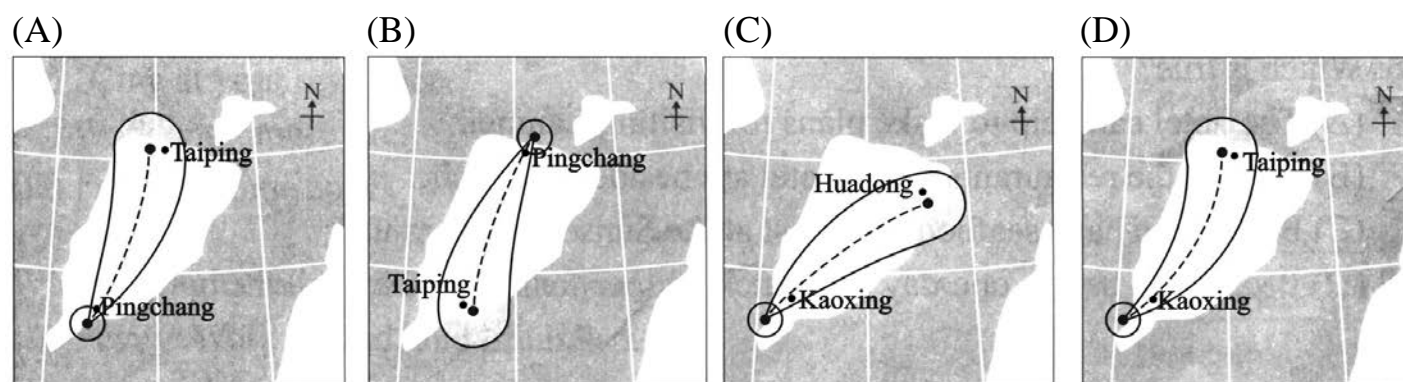

Most people write with their right hand and might also draw pictures, throw a ball, or hold a spoon with the same hand. However, some people are left-handed. Do you know our body is lopsided in other ways, too? Studies show that around 40% of us are left-eared, 30% are left-eyed, and 20% are left-footed. But only 10% are left-handed.

Here are some easy tests to find out how we naturally use our eyes, ears, and feet.

Test 1: Write your name on a piece of paper. Which hand do you use?
