

Most people write with their right hand and might also draw pictures, throw a ball, or hold a spoon with the same hand.

However, some people are left-handed. Do you know our body is lopsided in other ways, too? Studies show that around 40% of us are left-eared, 30% are left-eyed, and 20% are left-footed. But only 10% are left-handed.

Here are some easy tests to find out how we naturally use our eyes, ears, and feet.

Test 1: Write your name on a piece of paper. Which hand do you use?

Test 2: Choose a tree far in front of you. First, make a triangle with both hands and place the tree in the center of the triangle. Then close each eye in turn. The eye that shows the same view as the one you see with both eyes is your stronger eye.


