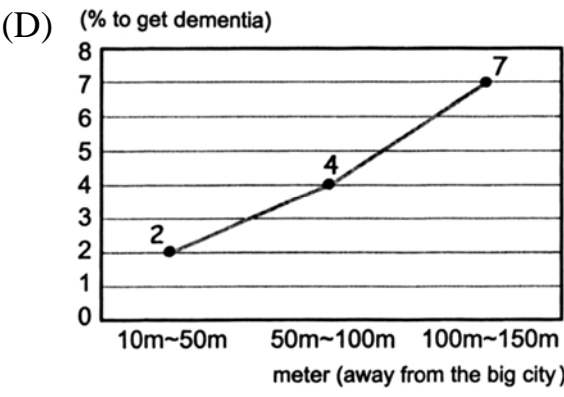

Around fifty million people around the world have dementia. Dementia will take away people’s memories and their power to remember things. Why do people get dementia? There is no sure answer to it. In the latest study, scientists followed about two million people in Canada between 2001 and 2012 and found: It often comes along with dirty air and heavy traffic. Dr. Martin Rossor says, “This is an important finding. We might need to keep studying to know more about it.”

Look at Chart 1 in the study. To people’s surprise, the chance of getting dementia for people living 50 meters away from the city center is three times higher than those living 150 meters away. That is, it’s possible for people to become sick if they live downtown. And people often get sick when they live in a big city with a lot of traffic and people. Scientists also say, “the best way to keep from getting dementia is to do things like exercising, eating healthily, and stopping smoking.”

Zoos are popular with adults and children. But are they really a good thing?


Some people think that animals get sick easily for being enclosed. Even the best places which are created by people can't come close to matching the space that animals have in their natural home. Keeping away from their natural home causes many zoo animals to become nervous or sick. Catching animals in the nature also breaks many families. Some zoos make animals perform unnaturally: for example, ocean parks often drive dolphins and whales to perform tricks. These animals may die dozens of years earlier than their natural ones, and some even try to kill themselves.

On the other hand, by bringing people and animals together, zoos are able to teach people about protecting them and their home. Some zoos provide a safe place for animals which have been treated badly in circuses, or pets which have been let go. Zoos also carry out important studies into subjects like animal actions and how to treat the diseases.

One of the most important modern work of zoos is supporting raising programs across the nations, especially for endangered animals. In the nature, some of them have slim chance in finding mates and raising their babies, and they might also be attacked and lose their home. A good zoo will keep these animals to live and give birth in safe places. What is more, as numbers of some nature-born animals drop, raising programs provide animals which are born and grow up in the zoos to be set free into the nature to make more different kinds of them.

However, opponents of zoos say that most of the raising programs do not set animals free back into the nature. Some of them are caught and sold to other zoos or to circuses or hunting farms in the US or South Africa, where some people are willing to pay a lot of money for the chance to kill an animal there. Often, these animals are friendly to people and have very little chance of running away.

So, are zoos good for animals or not? At least, many people believe treating animals as prisoners for any reason is simply wrong.
