

More and more young people in Taiwan are going on working holidays, to work in a foreign country while visiting it. Although there are many countries young people can choose from, Australia has always been Taiwanese people's favorite country for a working holiday (see Figure 1). It is said that it is not difficult to make one million NT dollars in Australia in only one year.

There are some interesting facts about Taiwanese people going on working holidays. First, the average age of the people who go on working holidays in other countries is 24.3 years old; however, it is 26.3 in Taiwan. A survey shows that what holds Taiwanese young people back from going on working holidays is that they do not have enough money to go abroad or their parents do not agree with this idea.

Second, there is a disparity between males and females who are going on working holidays (see Figure 2). The number of females is almost three times more than that of males. Some people think this is because Taiwanese young women are more willing to try new things; other people say the reason is that Taiwanese men have to spend about a year in the army, so they just want to get a job soon. But the real reasons are still unknown.
